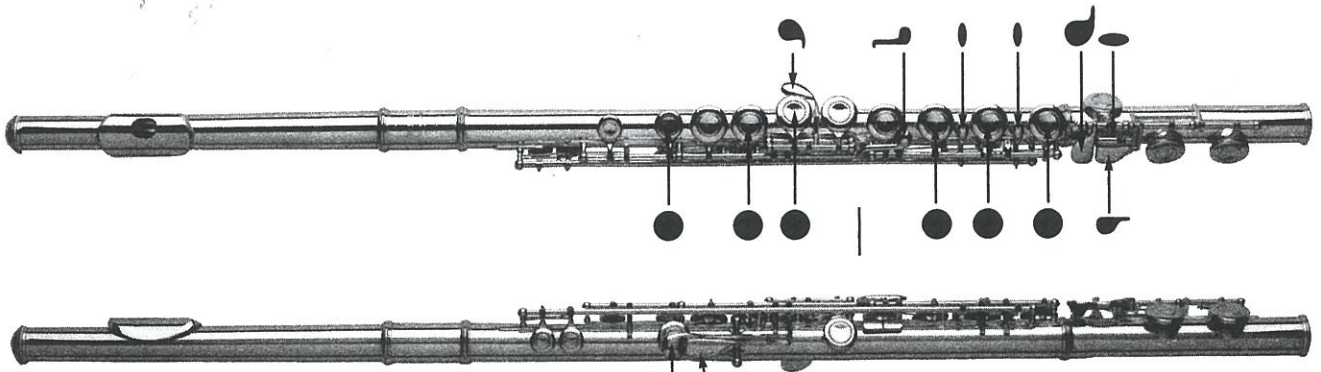


FINGERING CHART

Fingerings with gray thumb keys indicate that either thumb may be used for that note. Choose the best option for the line of music.

- = Open
- = Pressed down
- ◐ = Optional

The most common fingering appears first when more than one fingering is shown.

Instrument Care Reminders

Before putting your instrument back in its case after playing, do the following:

- Carefully remove the head joint.
- Put a clean soft cloth on the end of your cleaning rod and swab out the head joint.
- Twist the middle and foot joints apart and draw the cleaning rod through each joint.
- Carefully wipe the outside of each section to keep the finish clean.
